Your Elections Quick Guide

The Guild's annual Student Officer Elections are coming up! Here is your quick 60 second guide on everything you need to know:

What's the Guild?

The Guild is your Students' Union (SU) - a democratically-led organisation for all our student members.

What's a Student Officer?

Our 4 Student Officers are elected by University of Liverpool every year to lead the Guild (this means there's no job interview!) They represent the Student Voice on campus, advocating for students and campaigning on issues that matter to you.

Is this a real job?

Yes – being a Student Officer is a full-time, paid role! If you're elected, you'll work full-time with us for 1 year, starting in Summer 2025 (the exact start date will be released before Nominations open). This means you'd take a year out from your studies, if you're not graduating this year.

Why should I run?

This unique role gives you the opportunity to shape it to fit your goals, make real change, meet and learn from a diverse range of people & develop skills to help you in any career.
